A group of Norton residents have come together to respond to the proposed new Norton settlements, which form part of Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council's Regulation 18 Local Plan consultation.

Annual Christmas Party

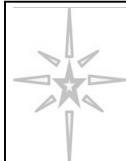
