Proposed Large Housing Development https://norton-heath.co.uk/ for around 10,000 houses + schools + enterprise, with most of the development to be within Norton Juxta Twycross boundary, bordering Snarestone & spanning the A444, the remaining in the area of Upper Rectory Farm, Appleby. Plus, other proposals near Twycross. A group of Norton residents have come together to respond to the proposed new Norton settlements, which form part of Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council's Regulation 18 Local Plan consultation.

Residents are deeply concerned about the potential impact on our countryside, local roads, schools, and rural communities. We are currently reviewing the consultation documents and evidence base to build a strong, fact-based case to protect our villages and the surrounding countryside. The **consultation opens on Friday 17th**October 2025, and every resident's voice matters.
